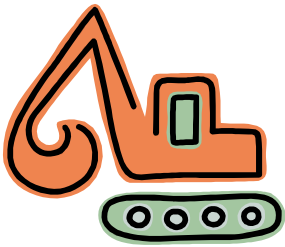


Fall & Winter Newsletter
